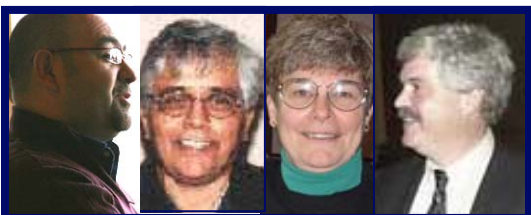
Nearly 60 organizations operating in urban, suburban and rural settings are part of the Foundation's growing national network.
